

Timeline

Pre-Grant Requirement:

Call Brienne or attend the Match Grant Q&A Session (TBD) by July 1, 2022

Phase I - DUE August 1, 2022

This *compelling* 1-page essay should include:

- Why your idea is worth the grant investment.
- How will the community be transformed by this project/program?
- Estimated Cost/Budget
- Community Partner (at least one)
- Money you are contributing (from a grant, donor, operating funds, etc.)
- How long will the project take?

Phase II Invitations - After August 19

If selected to move on to Phase II, you will receive a phone call from the Director requesting additional information on your project.

Phase II Information DUE - September 9

Project Meetings: September 12 - September 22

Your Project Team will need to be available for a meeting during this time. To be scheduled by the JNF Staff.

Finalists Contacted by September 22

Match Grant Finalists - Fundraising Challenge - Oct. 1 - 28

Your Project Team launches and leads a fundraising effort for 4 weeks.

Financial Reports DUE - November 7

Public Announcements Begin November 1

JNF will coordinate photo opportunities and social media/print media announcements of your grant, partners, and project timelines.
